Day 1

10:00am

After you disembark the ship, you will meet the Can Do Land Tour Team at the port gate which is about a 2 minute walk from the ship (we suggest that prior to disembarking the ship, you all meet as one group so you can travel to the meeting point together.)

We will leave by bus from the Port of Takoradi and head east of Ghana through the Central Region and it's small villages fishing villages to the Kakum National Park to do the sensational canopy walk.

1:00pm

We will arrive in Hans Cottage for Lunch.

2:00pm

After lunch we will continue our trip through several villages along the beautiful beaches of Ghana to Accra. Check into your hostel take a shower if necessary.

6:00pm

Time for us to have a delicious dinner with a Ghanaian local family.

Day 2

6:30am

There will be no breakfast so please get some cookies but there will be an early lunch by one of the biggest man-made lakes in the world after 2 hours drive from Accra. This lake also generates a large amount of

electricity to the whole country.

1:00pm

After lunch, we will depart to the highest waterfalls in West Africa, the Wil Waterfalls. Remember to pack your bathing suits as the falls has a platform for swimming.

4:30pm

We will travel to the Tafi Monkeys Sanctuary to visit and learn more about the monkeys that habitats this area!

Around dinner time, we will be surrounded by a drumming and dancing group at the Village Square.

Dancing is highly participatory in Ghana, so everyone is encouraged to participate and learn a few new moves! The evening will be crown with this memorable experience, but if you still have more energy, we make your way to the only pub in the village to sample a taste of all the quality local beers in the country. If you are interested in the pub, please remember to bring extra money.

Day 3

6:30am

Embark on another walking tour through a different rainforest to see and feed the Mona Monkeys (who are just as cute and nice at the Tafi!)

We will have some fun with the school children! Time to join the schools in the village where we will be divided into groups and attend to a classroom. In the afternoon, we will sadly say goodbye to our host families and friends before we depart to Tema (port). Our goal is to arrive at the Port of Tema around 4:30pm.
